Monday	Mark 14:3-9 She broke the jar and poured the ointment on his head. Some . . . said . . . “why this waste?” . . . and they were angry with her. But Jesus said, “Leave her alone.”
Tuesday	Isaiah 54:9-13 I swear never to be angry with you . . . my faithful love will never leave you, my covenant of peace will never totter . . .
Wednesday	Luke 19:41-42 As he drew near the city . . . he shed tears over it and said, “If you had only recognized the way to peace!”
Thursday	1 Peter 5:6-11 . . . the God of all grace . . . will confirm, strengthen and support you. His power lasts for ever . . .
Friday	Luke 7:36-50 . . . “her sins, many as they are, have been forgiven her, because she has shown such great love.”
Saturday	Psalms 34 Yahweh is near to the broken-hearted, he helps those whose spirit is crushed.
Sunday	Repetition – repeat any of the above readings as you feel drawn.
