

Readings for Week 3

(read full scripture text; any translation you choose)

Monday	Psalm 62:5-8 Rest in God alone, my soul! He is the source of my hope . . . trust in him . . . pour out your hearts to him . . .
Tuesday	Lamentations 3:22-26 Surely Yahweh's mercies are not over . . . every morning they are renewed . . . Yahweh is good to those who trust him, to all who search for him.
Wednesday	Matthew 6:25-34 "I am telling you not to worry about your life . . . Can any of you . . . add one single cubit to your span of life? . . . will (your Father) not . . . look after you?"
Thursday	Psalm 125 Whoever trusts in Yahweh is like Mount Zion: unshakeable, it stands forever . . . Yahweh encircles his people, henceforth and for ever.
Friday	Psalm 142 I pour out my worry in his presence . . . I unfold my troubles . . . listen to my calling . . . that I may praise your name.
Saturday	Mark 4:26-29 "This is what the kingdom of God is like . . . night and day . . . the seed is sprouting and growing . . . how, he does not know."
Sunday	Repetition – repeat any of the above readings as you feel drawn.
