

Readings for Week 4

(read full scripture text; any translation you choose)

Monday	Luke 6:12-13 (Jesus) went onto the mountain to pray; and he spent the whole night in prayer to God.
Tuesday	Philippians 4:4-9 The Lord is near . . . tell God all your desires . . . in prayer . . . shot through with gratitude, and the peace of God . . . will guard your hearts and thoughts.
Wednesday	John 16:12-15 “I still have many things to say to you . . . However, when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth.”
Thursday	Psalms 131 Yahweh, my heart is not haughty . . . I hold myself in quiet and silence, like a little child in its mother’s arms.
Friday	Matthew 18:1-4 . . . the disciples . . . said, “who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?” So he called a little child to him . . .
Saturday	Matthew 6:5-8 “. . . pray to your Father who is in that secret place . . . your Father knows what you need before you ask him.”
Sunday	Repetition – repeat any of the above readings as you feel drawn.
