Matthew 6:5-8 “ . . . pray to your Father who is in that secret place . . . your Father knows what you need before you ask him.”

Luke 11:5-13 “Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you.”

Romans 3:21-4:5 . . . God’s saving justice given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. No distinction is made.

1 John 5:14-15 . . . if we ask anything in accordance with his will he hears us.

Mark 4:35-41 . . . he said to them, “Why are you so frightened? Have you still no faith?” They were overcome with awe.

Isaiah 44:21-24 Remember these things . . . I formed you . . . I shall not forget you.

John 14:6-15 “Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? . . . whoever believes in me will perform the same works as I do myself.”

John 20:24-31 “You believe because you can see me. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe.”

1 John 5:1-11 . . . this is the victory that has overcome the world – our faith.
